On-demand electric minibus service

New on-demand electric minibus service for residents in the Braintree and Chelmsford area.



Residents in south Braintree and northwest Chelmsford areas can now access an exciting on-demand, fully electric minibus service called DigiGo. One of the first of its kind in the country, the service responds to demand rather

than having set routes, with minibuses able to divert on and off journeys for passenger collection and drop off.

DigiGo connects rural communities in north Chelmsford, including Felsted, Little Dunmow, Barnston, Leaden Roding, Good Easter, Pleshey, Great Waltham, Little Waltham and Great Leighs to popular locations such as Chelmer Valley Park and Ride, Broomfield Hospital, and Writtle University College.

Meanwhile, the service in south Braintree connects villages, including Great Notley, Black Notley and Rayne, to Braintree Bus Interchange, Braintree Railway Station, Braintree Community Hospital, Springwood Industrial Estate, Great Notley Country Park and many other locations.

The new service operates seven days a week, from 7am to 10pm and caters for everyone; students, families, the elderly, and people travelling to work, with accessible minibuses available for people with disabilities, providing a flexible and environmentally friendly service for people who do not live close to public transport routes. To book an on-demand journey, residents can download the TravelEssex planning app via their phone's app store or visit www.digigo.uk. After ordering, passengers can pay for their journey via the app and track the location of their minibus in real time. Tickets for the service can also be pre-booked up to seven days in advance.

Concessions travel for free after 9am on weekdays and at all times at weekends. Before 9am on weekdays the standard fares apply.

Alternatively, there is a telephone booking option for those unable to use the app 03330 137 138. This is available Monday to Friday. 10am untill 12pm (excluding bank holidays).

Councillor Lee Scott, Cabinet Member for Highways Maintenance and Sustainable Transport at Essex County Council, said: "The DigiGo service is the first of its kind in the area, offering a new type of responsive shared public transport which enables people to simply book a journey to when and where they need to go.

"The aim through this trial is to create a service which really becomes embedded in local communities, attracting users of all ages and creating a platform to be rolled out in other parts of the county."

Recipe: Constance Spry's Original Coronation Chicken

INGREDIENTS - Serves 8

2.3kg (5lb) chicken

1 tbsp vegetable oil

1 small, finely chopped onion

1 tbsp curry paste

1 tbsp tomato purée

100ml (4 fl oz) red wine

1 bay leaf

Juice of 1/2 a lemon

4 finely chopped apricot halves 300ml (1/2 pint) Mayonnaise

100ml (4 fl oz) whipping cream

Salt and pepper

Watercress to garnish



Original menu for the Queen's coronation celebration 'Poulet Reine Elizabeth'

Instructions:

- 1) Skin the chicken and cut into small pieces and grill it until cooked.
- 2) In a small saucepan, heat the oil, add the onion and cook for about three minutes, until softened.
- 3) Add the curry paste, tomato purée, wine, bay leaf and lemon juice.
- 4) Simmer, uncovered, for about 10 minutes until well reduced.
- 5) Strain and leave to cool.
- 6) Purée the chopped apricot halves in a blender or food processor or through a sieve.
- 7) Beat the cooled sauce into the mayonnaise with the apricot purée.
- 8) Whip the cream to stiff peaks and fold into the mixture.
- 9) Season, adding a little extra lemon juice if necessary.
- 10) Fold in the chicken pieces, garnish with watercress and serve.



A very warm welcome from Felsted Parish Council, the Felsted Events Committee and all the FOCUS team to this special edition of the FOCUS. We hope you will understand that we have had to shorten a few of our regular features for this Special Jubilee Edition but be assured, normal service will resume in the autumn.

■ The Beacon - 9.45pm

On Thursday 2 June we shall be joining thousands of communities, charities and groups across the UK



and the commonwealth to light Felsted's beacon to pay tribute to The Queen, a tradition started in 1897 for Queen Victoria.

We will be co-ordinating our beacon with more than 1500 others being lit across the UK, including those on top of the four highest peaks - Ben Nevis, Scotland; Scafell Pike, England; Mount Snowdon, Wales, and Slieve Donard, Northern Ireland.

The Bells and a Blessing

There are over 5000 bell towers across churches in the UK and just 300 elsewhere in the world! So, a Felsted Jubilee celebration wouldn't be complete without the sound of our bells ringing out from Holy Cross church's magnificent Norman tower.

Our wonderful ringers will be opening events for us on both the 2 and 3 June in a uniquely English style led by bell Captains Vicky Le Fe'vre and Ian Cresshull.

On Thursday 2 the bells of Holy Cross will ring out in the evening from 8 minutes to 8pm until precisely 22 minutes passed the hour. Got it yet? On the 24 hour clock, that means from 1952hrs to 2022hrs, a 30 minute peel that represents the dates of the 70 years of Her Majesty's reign from 1952 to 2022.

2 June

Ringing will end just in time to allow the ringers to join the rest of us at 9.35pm on the Parish Playing Fields behind the Memorial Hall to enjoy the Reverend Colin Taylor bless the flame that lights our magnificent beacon, hear Janet Johnson pipe in the flame and watch the beacon being lit.

The bells will ring again on Friday the 3 June to mark the opening of Celebrations at 2pm on the Playing Fields.

■ The Bagpipes


Her Majesty has a lifelong affection for the sound of the pipes, so Felsted piper, Janet Johnston has been practising a tune especially written for the event 'Diu Regnare' (Long to Reign in Latin), a stiring march, written by world champion Pipe Major Stuart Liddell.

Janet will join pipers around the globe who will be playing this tune across all time zones prior to the UK beacon lighting.

The Felsted beacon will be lit on the Memorial field, in unity with the rest of the UK at 9.45pm, whereas Commonwealth beacons will be lit at varying local times after sunset.



Please join us in marking this historic occasion, on the Parish Playing Field behind the Memorial Hall, starting promptly at 9.35pm on Thursday 2 June 2022.

FOCUS on Platinum!

The Jubilee event on Friday 3 June will feature a packed schedule of music and entertainment for the whole family. So that you don't miss your favourite act we'll try to be as punctual as we can, but timings may be adjusted on the day.

- **2.00pm** Our day begins to the sound of the Felsted Steel band and a parade around the parish playing field led by Queen Elizabeth, our very own local royalty, waving and being majestic, together with a whole crowd of Felsted primary school children in Royal themed fancy dress and still more from the White Court Dance group. You may even notice the odd Viking following on!
- **2.15pm** The opening ceremony will begin with HMQ declaring the event open and will conclude with the Felsted Choral Society singing the national anthem and Handel's Zadoc the Priest, the Coronation anthem first sung for the coronation of George II in 1727 and at every Coronation since. It's amazing!
- **2.30pm** The afternoons musical extravaganza begins with the first of
- two sets by the Felsted Steel Band, performing right next to the main stage. This hugely popular band has an amazing set including music from the Caribbean right up to date with big time rock numbers. Whatever the weather, the band




have you on your feet all evening. Between their sets, they will also provide a great club vibe.

It has been a very busy and productive time at Felsted Primary School. Over the last three months despite the continued covid issues we have achieved so much!

Our extremely generous parents helped us to raise £642 and a



huge amount of donated items for Felsted Aid which has helped those in need in the Ukraine. We are very proud of the generosity and kindness of our school community in these difficult times. We were invited to help plant a tree as part of the Queen's Green Canopy project. This is planted on the green outside school and the children

We will be holding our Grandparents Day – this is a lovely occasion where grandparents come and spend some time in class. Our outdoor swimming pool will be opened and lessons will take place during this term. We are very lucky to have this fantastic resource on site and the children gain so much from these lessons.
