## **FELSTED PARISH COUNCIL**

## Minutes of the 1083rd meeting held on 4 November 2020

## at 6:30 pm using the Zoom online platform

**Present:** Councillors Graham Harvey, Andy Bennett, Alec Fox, Richard Freeman, Penny Learmonth, Frances Marshall, John Moore, Roy Ramm. District Councillors John Evans and Sandi Merifield were also present along with 10 members of the public.

In attendance: The Clerk, 2 Assistant Clerks and the RFO.

## 20/179 Apologies for Absence and Declarations of Interest

Apologies for absence had been received from Councillors Peter Rose and Richard Silcock and County Councillor Simon Walsh. There were no Declarations of Interest.

#### 20/180 Public Forum

**180.1 Deep Puddles** – These are particularly bad outside of the URC Hall and Merrybones in Braintree Road. The Clerk confirmed that both matters had been reported to ECC Highways on more than one occasion. Highways believe the problem re Merrybones is the drainage across the field. Previously Highways pumped out the culvert to resolve the issue. The Clerk will contact Highways and request that they repeat the procedure. The issue outside of the URC Hall is recurring and is to do with the pipework under the road.

**180.2 Footpath Marker** – The FP marker on FP61 off of Mill Road is rotten/broken. The Clerk will report it.

Allotment Fencing Works – Following significant thefts at the allotments council agreed to erect fencing/gates (minute 20/117) and work has commenced. Concerns were raised by local residents re restriction of access to the allotments. Cllr Roy Ramm will meet with a local resident at the allotments to look at the site and report back to next PC meeting. Meantime no further works will be carried out.

## 20/182 Minutes of Meeting 1082 held on 7 October 2020

The Minutes were unanimously approved. They will be signed by the Chairman when the Council next meets in person.

# 20/183 Minutes of the Finance Committee meeting on 14 October and the Planning Committee meeting on 20 October 2020

These Minutes were noted and will be formally approved at the next meeting of the respective Committees.

## 20/184 **District Councillors Report**

Members noted the Report for November 2020 which included the following topics: the new Local Plan, Stansted Airport Appeal and the Station Road Gladman Appeal.

## 20/185 Matters arising from the October Council meeting

**185.1 Waste Bin in Church porch (Item 20/162.1)** - The large waste bin for the church porch should be in place by the end of November.

- **185.2 White hatched area between the Alms Houses/The Chequers (Item 20/162.2)** The Village Attendant is still awaiting dry weather in order to perform this task.
- **185.3 Seat outside Alms Houses (Item 20/162.3)** Drier weather is also needed for the Village Attendant to inspect the seat.
- **185.4 Replacement Tree on Memorial Hall Field (Item 20/162.4)** North End Nurseries are awaiting larger stakes which they will use with rubber ties to pull the tree upright again.
- 185.5 Woodley's Car Park (Item 20/162.10) The re surfacing works have been completed.
- 185.6 Future works specifications (Item 20/162.11) The Clerk confirmed that an article had

appeared in the Felsted Focus. No responses had been received.

**185.7 Coronavirus situation (Item 20/168) –** The second national lockdown commences 5<sup>th</sup> November. Current advice is that play areas will remain open. Football will stop at local level. The MUGA will be closed to stop groups meeting.

**185.8 Fire Extinguisher Annual Service** (Item 19/188.1) has been carried out by Anglia Fire Protection at a cost of £65.52

**185.9 PAT Test** – (Item 19/239.1) Electrical Equipment Testing is now due. Clerk will contact BFR Electrical Testing to arrange.

**185.10 UDC Tree Planting Initiative** - (Item 20/157.1) The PC have been offered 19 trees for Watch House Green, Willows Green and the Nature Area. Delivery is expected during the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of December. The trees will be delivered to Cllr Graham Harvey.

## 20/186 County Councillor Report

Members noted the November Report from County Cllr Simon Walsh which included the following topics: Coronavirus, rates of infection and ECC response. Attention was also drawn to the availability of grants for small projects of local importance.

## 20/188 Filling of Councillor Vacancy

Following permission given by UDC to co-opt, two extremely good candidates applied to join the PC. Each Councillor voted by e mail for their preferred candidate. Margaret Attwood received a majority of the votes cast and the Chairman accordingly invited her to join the council. She will be joining the PC at the December PC meeting.

## 20/189 Finance

**189.1 Payments –** The list of payments on pages7/8 were approved.

**189.2 Receipts** – Members noted that there were not any receipts so far this month.

**189.3 Felsted Community Trust** - A Barclays Community Account is to be opened. Cllr Graham Harvey and Cllr Frances Marshall will be the initial signatories on the account.

**189.4 Online banking update** – It was proposed by Cllr Roy Ramm, seconded by Cllr Richard Freeman and unanimously approved that Daniel Plunkett the RFO will be a signatory on the account in order to facilitate the setting up of online payments. It was noted that Cllr Graham Harvey and Cllr Roy Ramm will regularly check the bank statement reconciliations.

## 20/190 Finance Committee Matters

**190.1** Approval of revised Financial Risk Assessment and Asset Register – Proposed by Cllr Roy Ramm, Seconded by Cllr Alec Fox and approved unanimously.

**190.2 Approval of Felsted Nature Area Financial Policy** - Proposed by Cllr Frances Marshall, Seconded by Cllr Alec Fox and unanimously approved

**190.3 Approval of Crix Green Mission works contract to fit out the shell -** Proposed by Cllr Richard Freeman, Seconded by Cllr Frances Marshall and agreed (7 in favour and 1 abstention)

#### 20/191 Other Finance Matters

**Felsted Focus Magazine Review of Funding** – It was proposed by Cllr John Moore, seconded by Cllr Frances Marshall and approved unanimously to continue to financially support the village magazine until March 2021. The funding would then be reviewed.

## 20/192 **Staffing matters**

The PC noted the following staff appointments: Clare Schorah joined the PC as Assistant Clerk on 2<sup>nd</sup> November, Heather Read will take over the role of Clerk on 1<sup>st</sup> December. The current Clerk Diane Smith will retire on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020. The RFO, Daniel Plunkett, had successfully completed his 6 month probationary period and his first Staff Appraisal had been carried out.

## 20/193 Playing Fields

**193.1 Bannister Green Fence –** The installation of the replacement fence has now been satisfactorily completed.

**193.2 CIF grant application/additional play equipment at Willows Green play area** – Asst Clerk confirmed that the Community Infrastructure Fund had awarded a £6000 match funded grant for the provision of additional equipment for the Willows Green play area. Members considered various options/suppliers contained in a report pre circulated by the Asst Clerk. The appointment of Creative Play to install a seesaw, a spinner, an adventure trail and two toddler springers at a cost of £12213 was proposed by Cllr Richard Freeman and seconded by Cllr Frances Marshall. This was approved unanimously.

## 20/194 Causeway End flooding update

ECC floods team have cleared the culvert. Concern was expressed that the problem may have been moved further downstream. The water course engineer is due to meet the landowner of the fields further downstream in November. It is hoped a date will be agreed to carry out further works as required.

## 20/195 Chairman's matters

**195.1 County Broadband** – This was due to be available some time ago but is still not in place. Residents wishing to cancel have been informed that they cannot, whilst cheaper contracts are being offered to new customers. Concern was expressed that several residents had been asked for substantial extra payments towards installation following the signing of their contracts. The PC will write to County Broadband/Super Fast Essex requesting clarity and asking what is happening (when will the service be ready and why residents are being asked for more money/not being allowed to cancel after such a delay) The letter will be copied to both District and County Councillors and the local MP.

**195.2 The Chequers** – The PC noted with sadness that Wendy Barker the landlady is retiring shortly which will end a family connection with the pub over the last 65 years. Cllr Frances Marshall proposed that the PC present Wendy with some flowers to show appreciation for all that she has done for the village over many years. This was seconded by Cllr Alec Fox and unanimously agreed.

## 20/196 Clerk's Matters

**196.1 Public Toilets** - A resident had expressed interest in locking/unlocking the toilets weekdays but was unavailable for weekends. The alternative of automatic time locks for both toilets purchased/installed from Healthmatic at a cost of £1690 plus vat was proposed by Cllr Andy Bennett and seconded by Cllr Richard Freeman. This was unanimously agreed.

**196.2 Document Retention Policy** – It was agreed that a sentence should be added to clarify the format of the documents being referred to (paper or digital). With this amendment, this was unanimously approved.

**196.3 Churchyard wall works** – The planning application has been submitted. Copies of the

drawings have been received and will be used in order to obtain quotes for the work.

**196.4 Tree Works** – As agreed at the October meeting (minute 20/172) due to the urgency of the issues revised quotes had been accepted in principle from JCM Services, to undertake the work on the large copper beech in the churchyard £2340 and the Oak Tree at Bannister Green £150. Quotes are to be obtained for work on the 3 trees in the playing field bordering Jolly Boys Lane North.
